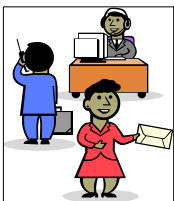

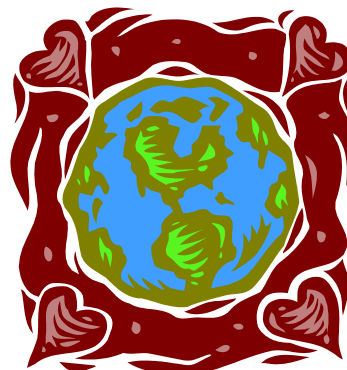

The meeting of the GFWC Jupiter-Tequesta Junior Woman's Club was called to order by President Claire Portmann at 7:11 p.m. The meeting was held at the Church of Good Shepherd on Seabrook Dr. in Tequesta.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the United States of America was recited followed by the Junior Pledge.

Past Presidents were introduced: Sheryl Molter, Jeanne Takeda and Joyce Ross.

Claire Portmann welcomed guests, Linda Ferris of GFWC Greater WPB Club, Mary Evelyn Mitchell (new district director) GFWC Greater WPB Club and Dionna Farmer of Sebastian Jr. Women's Club, District 10.

### **Previous Minutes**

Sheryl Molter made a motion to approve the minutes of February 10, 2014. The motion was seconded by Mary Bergen and approved by all members

### **Membership**

There were 13 members in attendance at the meeting.

Sheryl Molter presented Linda Ferris, a Past Jr. District Director, whose club, GFWC Greater West Palm Beach Woman's Club, has received the Emmy for being the outstanding Woman's Club 3 times.
